INTRODUCTION

The fifth symposium of the series of Drug Discovery and Therapy conferences was again held in Dubai from February 18-21, 2013 at Dubai Women's College, UAE. The success trend of these conferences even this year attracted a huge audience, setting the stage for an august assemblage of scientists and researchers to present their research work and raise the curtain from the state-of-the-art developments coming about throughout the world in the field of drug discovery and therapy. INAUGURAL CEREMONY




GALA DINNER ON DHOW CRUISE:
